Housing Sales Increase in Hillsborough County

The battered Hillsborough County housing market showed solid evidence of battling back in the latest figures released by the Greater Tampa Association of REALTORS® (GTAR).

March sales of all housing units showed an increase of 42.9 percent from the previous month. A total of 1,162 units sold throughout the county in March compared with 813 for the month of February. The March figures also reflect an increase of 46 percent from January's total of 791 units sold.

“This is outstanding news for the overall economy of Hillsborough County,” said GTAR President Deborah Farmer. “These figures are welcomed news to the local business community.”

Carol Austin, CEO of the REALTOR® association added, “We have seen signs for several months that the market was turning in a positive fashion and this is solid evidence that it is indeed on the rebound.”
